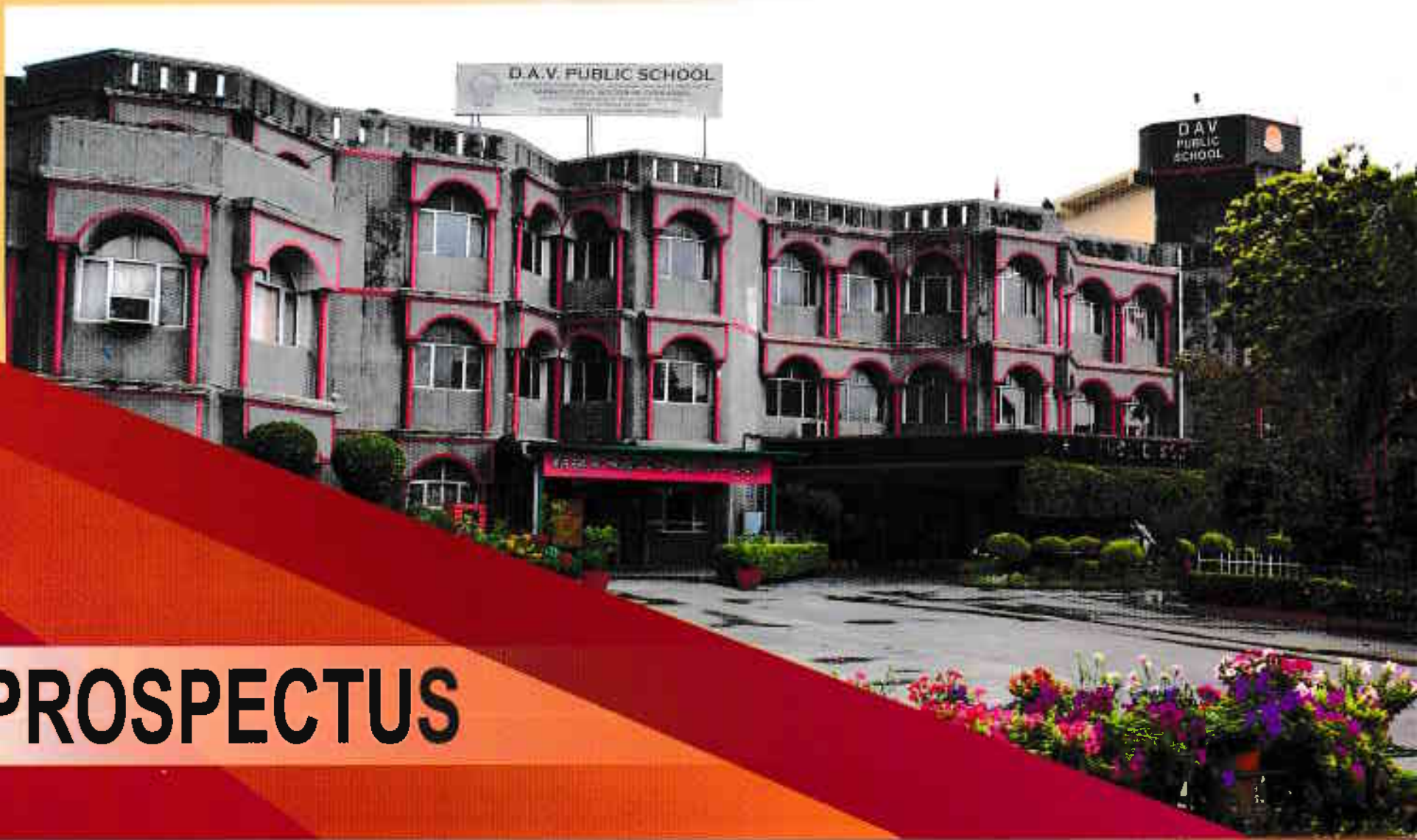

MUN: MODEL UNITED NATIONS

The DAVites at Middle and Senior Secondary Levels are constantly motivated to participate in MUN where they learn public speaking, leadership, team work and international harmony. It is a diplomatic competition where students express their country's beliefs, maintaining international beliefs.

PARENT TEACHER MEETINGS AND SMS FACILITY:

The school knows how important it is to involve parents in their ward's education and school performance, which is why, we prioritize parents' communication with meetings, discussions, text alerts and open houses.

PTM is held once a month -usually on Saturday/after examination to apprise parents of the progress of their wards. In case of urgency the parents may be called to meet the school authorities/class teacher with prior information to the parent(s). At the meeting, a mutual exchange of ideas between parents and the teachers take place and both together try to formulate a common strategy to help the child.

Through SMS Alert Service, the parents are regularly apprised about the school activities, PTMs, Examination Schedule, progress of the child.





RULES AND REGULATIONS

Uniform: School uniform is a must for the uniformity in the appearance so as to avoid any type of complex amongst the students. Students must maintain a sober, dignified appearance. Students are supposed to wear prescribed uniform. No student is allowed in the school bus or compound without proper uniform. On PTM/other non teaching days also, students must report to the school in proper uniform only. Common for all DAV Schools, the uniform is a discipline in itself and must be adhered to. The new pattern of uniform is in fawn colour and checked print. The pattern varies for students from classes LKG to II, III to V, VI to VII and IX to XII respectively. Fawn coloured socks and brown shoes must be worn by all. House uniform is to be worn once in a week. Identity card is a must.

School Diary: Every student must have the School Diary of the current session. He/ she must carry this important document to the school everyday. The diary has to be checked and signed by the parent after making sure the ward has completed the home assignments. For personal safety and identity, diary is a must.

Punctuality: School is very strict about the punctuality. Strict measures for the late comers are undertaken in order to modify them.

Discipline: A code of conduct is to be followed by the students. Acts of violence, use of abusive language, violation of discipline shall be strictly viewed. In the school buses also, the students must maintain their dignity and courtesy.

For students, carrying of mobile or any electronic equipment is debarred.

Examinations:

- There is no formal examination in classes LKG, UKG, I and II.
- The examinations are conducted as per C.B.S.E for classes III to X including Formative Assessment and Summative Assessment for two semesters in an academic session. For classes XI, XII too, the school follows C.B.S.E. guidelines.
- The D.A.V. Public Schools have their own DAV Education Board which conducts exams for class VIII.

Attendance and Leave:

1. Each student is expected to have at least 90% attendance record during an academic session.
2. In case of a sick leave, proper leave letter written and signed by the parent/guardians, supported by a medical certificate should be submitted.
3. A serious action is imperative against any child who misses any class or leaves the school before time without prior permission.
4. If half day leave is required, the student can leave the school premises only with the parents who attend the P.T.M or are known to the class teacher.
5. If a student remains absent from the school for 30 days without information, his/her name will be struck off the rolls.

Essential Guidelines:

- For security reasons, the school will not accept any lunch boxes or other miscellaneous things. The child must himself/herself bring all the essentials required in the school.
- In case of an emergency of any kind regarding your ward, the parent can be called. Your co-operation will be highly appreciated.
- Any change in student's residential address/contact number must be conveyed to the accounts office and class teacher immediately, by filling up the required form.
- Students are not allowed to bring two wheelers-bikes/scooty etc. Parking of such vehicles in the neighbouring area is not the responsibility of the school.
- After admission of the student to the school, the required certificates must be submitted within 15 days from the date of depositing fees.
- For access to the latest information, log on to the school website www.davsec49.org.in
Important information is conveyed to the parents through SMS at the mobile number specified by the parents.

Vacations:

In an academic session, the school closes down for:

- (i) Autumn Break
- (ii) Winter Break and
- (iii) Summer Vacations.



FEE

Mode of Payment:

- Fee is payable bi-monthly by the 15th of the first month for which fee is due, except January and April.
- In January, students will pay fee for 3 months i.e. January, February and March.
- Only one month fee will be charged in the month of April, along with Annual Fee.
- May and June fee is to be paid by 15th of May; July and August fee by 15th of July; September and October fee by 15th of September; November and December fee by 15th of November.
- Admission fee is to be paid through Demand Draft only and shall not be refunded in any case.
- In case fee is not deposited in time, a fine of Rs. 5 per day will be charged.
- Fee can be paid by cheque/online/card.
- Fee is not accepted in cash.

For depositing fee dues through cheque, kindly refer to the following rules:-

- a. Cheque deposition facility is till 15th of each month.
- b. Cheque should be payable at par in Faridabad.
- c. In the month of April, for new admissions as well as Admission Renewals, fee is accepted by Demand Draft only.
- d. In case of cheque dishonor, a fine of Rs. 200 will be levied. Cheque should be drawn in favour of Principal, DAV Public School, Sainik Colony, Faridabad.
- e. Mention at the back side of the cheque - Name of ward, admission no., class, section, month for which fees is being paid through cheque.
- f. Parents should keep a record of their communication with school including the Receipts of fee, so that they can be handy while discussing any fee discrepancy.

Procedure for Withdrawal:

1. A calendar month's notice in writing or a month's fee is required for withdrawal from the school.
2. The school leaving certificate is issued free of charge. A fee of Rs. 50/- will be charged for a duplicate.

Refund of Caution Money:

1. Caution money will be refunded at the time of withdrawal from the school, on the production of caution money deposit receipt, after getting the NO DUES CERTIFICATE.
2. If no claim to the caution money is made within 3 months of the withdrawal from the school, the caution money will be forfeited.
3. Claim for the caution money is to be made on a prescribed application form. A cheque will be issued in the name of a parent (Mother or Father) whose name is mentioned on the prescribed application form.

TRANSPORT

Admission to the school does not mean automatic allocation of a seat in a school bus.

Parents are requested to refrain from making requests for change of route, diversion, additional stops and relocation of stops.

The routes and stops are fairly ascertained on the basis of the area to be covered. No request for changes in the bus route or stop will be entertained.

- One month as notice period or deposit of one month's fee for discontinuation of transport facility is required.
- Bus charges are for eleven months from April to March, as charges for June are not payable. No discontinuation of bus after November will be allowed.
- Rules & Regulations of bus facilities must be followed by the students.
- The school provides bus facility to the students (to the school and back) of classes L.K.G to XII from the convenient points. The school management tries to provide this facility to the maximum number of students. Bus facility for every student is not guaranteed.
- The children will be picked up only from the specified points.
